

1.1 Definitions:

- 1.2 The term 'entrant' shall mean an individual participant place on a Global Challenge UK Ltd Open Challenge.
- 1.3 The 'challenge' shall refer to the "Mighty Mount Snowdon" Climb, the Brecon Beacons "Top 10" Challenge or the Brecon "Bike-Tastic" Challenge.
- 1.4 The 'challenge date' is the 9th June (Snowdon); 7th July (Top 10); 15th September (Bike-Tastic).
- 1.5 The 'closing date' is 30th April 2012 (Snowdon); 31st May 2012 (Top 10); 31st July (Bike-Tastic).

2.1 Payment

- 2.2 The price for an individual entrant to Global Challenge UK Ltd (GCUK) will be £65 for the "Mighty Mount Snowdon" Climb & Brecon Beacons "Top 10" Challenge and £TBC for the Brecon 'Bike-Tastic' Challenge.
- 2.3 An entrant place will only be made available upon receipt of full payment to GCUK prior to the respective closing date.
- 2.4 Entrants may be purchased by charities or third party organisations in order to recruit participants. Where entrants are purchased by charities or third party organisations the purchaser named on the application shall be deemed as responsible for payment.
- 2.5 Entrants may not be transferrable without the written authorisation of GCUK.

3.1 Entrants

- 3.2 Where entrants are purchased by charities and or third party organisations in order to recruit fundraising participants, the participant's fundraising targets, fulfilment and collection of funds etc. is entirely the responsibility of the entrant purchaser.
- 3.3 For safety & logistics purposes, participants may be joined together in teams on the day of the challenge.
- 3.4 All participants must be 18 years of age or older on the day of the challenge.
- 3.5 Participants will be required to sign a medical form. This will be sent to all participants prior to the challenge. GCUK have the right to refuse a participant if they are deemed medically unfit to take part.

4.1 Transport & Accommodation

- 4.2 It is the participant's responsibility to arrange their own transport & accommodation requirements (accommodation lists & advice will be supplied by GCUK).

5.1 Cancellation & Postponement

- 5.2 GCUK does not expect the challenge to be cancelled. Should the challenge be cancelled by GCUK, GCUK shall immediately inform all entrants in writing. GCUK will reimburse to entrants all payments made at that time. GCUK reserve the right to cancel the challenge in the event that insufficient entrants are purchased.
- 5.3 GCUK does not expect the event to be postponed. Should GCUK wish to postpone the event to a later scheduled date, GCUK shall immediately inform all entrants in writing. A new event date will be scheduled. In the event that GCUK postpone the event, entrants reserve the right to withdraw their entry place and GCUK will reimburse to entrants all payments made at that time.
- 5.4 Should it become necessary for an entrant to relinquish their entrance, they must notify GCUK immediately in writing. Upon receipt of such notification, all entrant payments received at that date will be returned to the entrants. Should such notification be received by GCUK after the closing date, Global Challenge UK reserves the right to retain the payment received.
- 5.5 Participants should note weather conditions are unpredictable in the National Parks and situations may occur which are beyond the control of GCUK. In this extreme event the challenge itinerary may have to be altered at short notice from that advertised.

6.1 Insurance

- 6.2 Without prejudice to their liabilities under this agreement, GCUK shall insure with a reputable insurance company against death or injury to persons and loss or damage to physical property, to a value of £5,000,000. Entrant holders and participants should ensure that participant's personal insurance arrangements cover them for participation in this type of event.

7.1 Code of Conduct

- 7.2 GCUK adheres to the Institute of Fundraising's code of conduct for UK outdoor challenge events.

8.1 Equipment, Logistics & Safety

- 8.2 GCUK will provide information prior to the event, to each entrant holder/participant detailing road & challenge routes, logistics, timings, diet, training, and **compulsory clothing & safety equipment lists** etc. Participants will be responsible for ensuring they have the appropriate clothing & equipment as detailed on the **compulsory clothing & equipment list**. GCUK reserves the right to prevent any participant from taking part in the challenge should GCUK consider they are not equipped, dressed or prepared correctly for the challenge.

9.1 Dispute Resolution

- 9.2 If any dispute or difference which may arise between the entrant holder and GCUK in connection with or arising out of these terms & conditions is stated to be referred to Arbitration, then either party shall give to the other 14 days' written notice to such effect, and such dispute or difference shall be referred to a single Arbitrator agreed between the parties within 14 days after the date of the said written notice or in default of agreement as may be nominated by the President for the time being of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators.
